GARDENA Cordless Hedge Trimmer EasyCut Li-18/50



Translation of the original instructions from German. Please read these operating instructions carefully and observe the notes given. Use these operating instructions to familiarise yourself with the hedge trimmer, its proper use and the notes on safety.



For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 and people not familiar with these operating instructions must not use this hedge trimmer. Persons with reduced physical or mental abilities may use the hedge trimmer only if they are supervised or instructed by a responsible person. Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.

→ Please keep these operating instructions in a safe place.

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1. Where to Use Your GARDENA Cordless Hedge Trimmer

Correct Use:

This GARDENA Cordless Hedge Trimmer is intended for the cutting of hedges, shrubs and grass coverings in private domestic gardens and allotments.

Adherence to these operating instructions is a precondition for the correct use of the hedge trimmer.

Please note



WARNING ! Risk of injury!

The hedge trimmer must not be used for cutting lawns / lawn edges or for chopping up material for composting purposes.

2. Safety Instructions



If not used properly this product can be dangerous. The warnings and safety instructions must be followed to ensure reasonable safety and efficiency in using this product. The operator is responsible for following the warnings and instructions in this manual and on the product. Never use the product unless the guards provided by the manufacturer are in the correct position.

Explanation of Symbols on your product.



WARNING !

Read the user instructions carefully to make sure you understand all the controls and what they do.



Remove Battery before cleaning or maintenance.



**Do not expose to rain.
Do not leave the product outdoors while it is raining.**



The use of eye and hearing protection is recommended.

General Power Tool Safety Warnings

WARNING ! Read all safety warnings and all instructions. Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury.

Save all warnings and instructions for future reference.

The term "power tool" in the warnings refers to your mains operated (corded) power tool or battery-operated (cordless) power tool.

1) Work area safety

a) Keep work area clean and well lit.

Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.

b) Do not operate power tools in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases or dust. Power tools create sparks which may ignite the dust or fumes.

c) Keep children and bystanders away while operating a power tool. Distractions can cause you to lose control.

2) Electrical safety

a) Power tool plugs must match the outlet. Never modify the plug in any way. Do not use any adaptor plugs with earthed (grounded) power tools.

Unmodified plugs and matching outlets will reduce risk of electric shock.

b) Avoid body contact with earthed or grounded surfaces, such as pipes, radiators, ranges and refrigerators. There is an increased risk of electric shock if your body is earthed or grounded.

c) Do not expose power tools to rain or wet conditions. Water entering a power tool will increase the risk electric shock.

d) Do not abuse the cord. Never use the cord for carrying, pulling or unplugging the power tool. Keep cord away from heat, oil, sharp edges or moving parts. Damaged or entangled cords increase the risk of electric shock.

e) When operating a power tool outdoors, use an extension cord suitable for outdoor use. Use of a cord suitable for outdoor use reduces the risk of electric shock.

f) If operating a power tool in a damp location is unavoidable, use a residual current device (RCD) protected supply. Use of an RCD reduces the risk of electric shock.

3) Personal safety

a) Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when operating a power tool. Do not use a power tool while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of inattention while operating power tools may result in serious personal injury.

b) Use personal protective equipment. Always wear eye protection. Protective equipment such as dust mask, non-skid safety shoes, hard hat, or hearing protection used for appropriate conditions will reduce personal injuries.

c) Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting to power source and/or battery pack, picking up or carrying the tool. Carrying power tools with your finger on the switch or energising power tools that have the switch on invites accidents.

d) Remove any adjusting key or wrench before turning the power tool on. A wrench or a key left attached to a rotating part of the power tools may result in personal injury.

e) Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times. This enables better control of the power tool in unexpected situations.

f) Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing or jewellery. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewellery or long hair can be caught in moving parts.

g) If devices are provided for the connection of dust extraction and collection facilities, ensure these are connected and properly used. Use of dust collection can reduce dust-related hazards.

4) Power tool use and care

a) Do not force the power tool. Use the correct power tool for your application. The correct power tool will do the job better and safer at the rate for which it was designed.

b) Do not use the power tool if the switch does not turn it on and off. Any power tool that cannot be controlled with the switch is dangerous and must be repaired.

c) Disconnect the plug from the power source and/or the battery pack from the power tool before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing power tools. Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the power tool accidentally.

d) Store idle power tools out of the reach of children and do not allow persons unfamiliar with the power tool or these instructions to operate the power tool. Power tools are dangerous in the hands of untrained users.

e) Maintain power tools.

Check for misalignment or binding of moving parts, breakage of parts and any other condition that may affect the power tool's operation. If damaged, have the power tool repaired before use. Many accidents are caused by poorly maintained power tools.

f) Keep cutting tools sharp and clean. Properly maintained cutting tools with sharp cutting edges are less likely to bind and are easier to control.

g) Use the power tool, accessories and tool bits etc. in accordance with these instructions, taking into account the working conditions and the work to be performed. Use of the power tool for operations different from those intended could result in a hazardous situation.

5. Battery tool use and care

- a) Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer.** A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another battery pack.
- b) Use power tools only with specifically designated battery packs.** Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- c) When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects, that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.**
- d) Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery; avoid contact. If contact accidentally occurs, flush with water. If liquid contacts eyes, additionally seek medical help.** Liquid ejected from the battery may cause irritation or burns.

6. Service

Have your power tool serviced by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts. This will ensure that the safety of the power tool is maintained.

Hedge trimmer safety warnings:

- Keep all parts of the body away from the cutter blade. Do not remove cut material or hold material to be cut when blades are moving. Make sure the switch is off when clearing jammed material. A moment of inattention while operating the hedge trimmer may result in serious personal injury.
- Carry the hedge trimmer by the handle with the cutter blade stopped. When transporting or storing the hedge trimmer always fit the cutting device cover. Proper handling of the hedge trimmer will reduce possible personal injury from the cutter blades.
- Hold the power tool by insulated gripping surfaces only, because the cutter blade may contact hidden wiring. Cutter blades contacting a "live" wire may make exposed metal parts of the power tool "live" and could give the operator an electric shock.

Additional Safety Recommendations

Work area safety

Only use the product in the manner and for the functions described in these instructions.

The operator or user is responsible for accidents or hazards occurring to other people or their property.

Electrical safety

Only use the charger on the AC mains supply voltage shown on the product rating label.

Under no circumstances should an earth be connected to any part of the product.

Personal safety

Always wear suitable clothing, gloves, and stout shoes.

Inspect the areas where the hedge trimmer is to be used and remove all wires, hidden electrical cables and other foreign objects.

Prior to use and after a severe impact, check the machine for any indications of fracture or damage.

Before using the machine and after any impact, check for signs of wear or damage and repair as necessary. Never attempt to use an incomplete product or one with an unauthorised modification.

Power tool use and care

Know how to stop the product quickly in an emergency.

Never hold the product by the guard.

Do not use the Hedge Trimmer if the protection equipment (hand protection, 2-hand safety switch, protection cover, quick blade-stop) are damaged.

Do not use ladders whilst operating the product.

Remove the battery:

- before leaving the product unattended for any period;
- before clearing a blockage;
- before checking, cleaning or working on the appliance;
- if you hit an object. Do not use your product until you are sure that the entire product is in a safe operating condition;
- if the product starts to vibrate abnormally. Check immediately. Excessive vibration can cause injury.
- before passing to another person.

Maintenance and storage



- When work is finished or interrupted, refit the protective blade cover.

All nuts and screws must be fastened tightly to be sure the device is in a safe working condition.

Battery safety



- Never charge the batteries near acids or easily inflammable materials.

Only use the original GARDENA Battery Charger for charging. The use of other battery chargers may damage the batteries irreparably and even cause a fire.



- Protect battery from heat and fire. Do not leave on radiators or expose to strong sunshine for long periods.



- Protect the the battery charger from damp or wet areas.

Only use the battery in ambient temperatures of between 0 °C and 40 °C.

A non-functioning battery must be disposed of correctly. It may not be sent via post.

For further details, please contact your local disposal companies.

The charging cable should be checked regularly for signs of damage or ageing (brittleness) and may only be used if it is in perfect condition.

The charger unit provided may only be used to charge the rechargeable batteries supplied with the Hedge Trimmer.

Non-rechargeable batteries must not be charged with this battery charger (danger of fire).

Disconnect the charger from the mains and battery after charging.


Only charge battery between 0 – 45 °C. After heavy duty service allow battery to cool down first.

Storage:


The trimmer must not be stored over 35 °C or under direct exposure to sunlight.

Do not store the Hedge Trimmer in places with static electricity.

3. Assembly



Fitting the front handle:



DANGER ! Risk of physical injury !

Cutting injuries can be caused if the hedge trimmer does switch on unintentionally.


→ Remove the battery before assembling the hedge trimmer (see 4. Operation) and slide the protective cover ⑩ over the cutter blade.



ATTENTION ! Safety guard !

The guide handle ① is only a safety guard for the 2-handed trigger when the spring ⑤ is correctly inserted.

1. Insert the wide side of the spring ⑤ into the lower casing ④ and the lower side into the upper casing ⑥ and close the guide handle ①.
2. Push the guide handle ① over the slot in the hedge trimmer and ensure it is fully in place and the handle hole ② is lined up with the threaded hole ②.
3. Secure the guide handle ① to the hedge trimmer using the two screws ③.



4. Initial Operation






WARNING !

Overvoltage damages batteries and the battery charger.

→ Ensure the correct mains voltage.

Charging the battery:

Before using for the first time, the battery must be fully charged. Charging time (for uncharged battery) see 10. Technical Data.



The lithium-ion battery can be charged in any state of charge, and the charging process can be interrupted at any time without harming the battery (no memory effect).

1. Depress both locking buttons ④ and remove the battery ⑤ from the battery holder ⑥ on the handle.
2. Plug the plug of the charger cable ⑦ into the battery ⑤.
3. Plug battery charger ⑧ into a mains socket.

Charging control lamp ⑨ at the charger unit flashes green once per second: Battery is being charged.

Charging control lamp ⑨ at the charger unit is lit green: Battery is fully charged.

(For charging time, see 10. Technical Data.)

Battery charging status indicator during charging:

100 % charged	L1, L2 and L3 lit.
66 – 99 % charged	L1 and L2 lit, L3 flashing.
33 – 65 % charged	L1 lit, L2 flashing.
0 – 32 % charged	L1 flashing.
4. First remove the charging cable ⑦ from the charging socket and then unplug the battery charger ⑧ from the mains socket.	
5. Slide the battery ⑤ on the battery holder ⑥ on the handle until it audibly engages.	

Avoid exhaustive discharge:

If the battery is empty, the full discharge protection automatically switches off the device to prevent the battery from discharging fully.

To prevent the fully charged battery from self-discharging via the unplugged charger, it should be disconnected from the charger after charging. If the battery was stored for more than 1 year, it must be fully recharged.

If the battery was fully discharged, the charging indicator lamp ⑨ will flash rapidly at the start of charging (twice per second).

If the charging indicator lamp ⑨ still flashes rapidly after 10 minutes, a fault has occurred (see 8. Troubleshooting).

If the error-LED ⑩ on the battery flashes, a fault has occurred (see 8. Troubleshooting). In case of a completely empty battery it will take approx. 20 minutes until the LEDs on the battery will indicate charging. But the charging process is indicated by the flashing LED ⑨ on the charger.








The hedge trimmer can be operated in 3 working positions.




Side trimming:

→ Take guide handle ① at the top (a).


Starting the Hedge Trimmer:



DANGER ! Risk of physical injury!

If the Hedge Trimmer does not switch off automatically, there is a risk of lacerations.

→ Never override the safety devices (e.g. by strapping down one of the start buttons).




Switching the Hedge Trimmer on:

The hedge trimmer is fitted with a two-handed safety device (2 start buttons) to prevent the unit from being turned on by accident.

1. Push the battery onto the handle (see 4. Initial Operation).
2. Remove the protective cover ⑩ from the cutter blade ⑪
3. Hold the guide handle ① with one hand and press the start button ⑫.
4. Hold the main handle ⑭ with the other hand and press the start button ⑬.

The hedge trimmer will start.




Switching the Hedge Trimmer off:

1. Release the two start buttons ⑫ / ⑬.
2. Remove the battery from the handle (see 4. Initial Operation).
3. Slide the protective cover ⑩ over the cutter blade ⑪.

6. Storage

Storage:



The hedge trimmer must be stored out of the reach of children.

1. Remove the battery and charge (see 4. Initial Operation).
2. Clean the hedge trimmer (see 7. Maintenance) and slide the protective cover ⑩ over the cutter blade ⑪.
3. Store the hedge trimmer in a dry, frost free place.



Cleaning the Hedge Trimmer:



ATTENTION ! Damage to the hedge trimmer !

→ Never clean the hedge trimmer under running water or with a water jet (in particular a high pressure water jet).

1. Clean the hedge trimmer with a damp cloth.
2. Where necessary, clean the trimmer blade ⑪ with a brush and lubricate with a low viscosity oil (e.g. GARDENA Spray-oil Art. 2366). Avoid contact of the oil with the plastic parts and wear gloves.

→ Remove the battery before troubleshooting (see 4. Initial Operation) and slide the protective cover ⑩ over the cutter blade ⑪.

If a fault occurs with your hedge trimmer, please return the faulty unit together with the receipt and a description of the fault, with postage paid to the address of the Service Centre at the back of these operating instructions.
