
NOTICE!

Bolts should be snug, but do not overtighten. Otherwise the bolts may break.



For most installations including wood, stucco, masonry and concrete, use hardware components (9), (10) and (10)*.

*For solid wood do not use anchors.

1. SAFETY WARNINGS

1.1 Explanation of the symbols on the product

CAUTION!

→ Read the operating Instructions before initial operation.

DANGER!

Physical injury through prestressed springs. → The Hose reel may not be opened.

1.2 Explanation of the safety warnings



Type and source of hazard.

Indicates a hazardous situation which, if not avoided, could result in minor or moderate injury.

1.3 General safety warnings

- →Read the operator's manual carefully before use and keep for future reference.
- →Never operate the product when you are tired, ill or under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medicine.
- →This product contains springs that are under tension and could result in injury if the product is operated by someone who is: unfamiliar with this product, needs adult supervision, or has impaired judgment due to fatigue, medication, or other substances that can impair judgment or coordination.
- →Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- \rightarrow Never drink the water from the hose.
- \rightarrow Never use hot water with this product.
- \rightarrow Do not place any additional load on the wall bracket.
- \rightarrow Depressurise the hose when not in use.
- →Regularly inspect the bracket and securing pins for signs of wear and tear.

1.4 Intended use:

The Hose reel is inteded for use with cold water for outdoor irrigation only. This hose is **not** inteded to be used as a drinking water hose.

The product is intended exclusively for use in private household gardens or on private allotments.

2. ASSEMBLY



Risk of suffocation.

Small parts can be easily swallowed. Toddlers can suffocate on the polybag.

 \rightarrow Keep toddlers away when you assemble the product.

2.1 To assemble a watering tool [Fig. A]

You can either assemble a watering tool to the hose with the supplied bonus adapters (see *To use the GARDENA quick connect system:*).

Or by drilling the watering tool directly onto the accessory end connector (5) of the hose.

As a watering tool, use the supplied nozzle $\textcircled{\sc 0}$ or your individual nozzle or sprinkler.

To use the GARDENA quick connect system:



→ Combine the provided bonus adapters ⑦ (Art. 6924) and the Accessory End Quick Connector ④ (Art. 18218).

- 1. Drill your watering tool onto the adapters ④ and ⑦.
- 2. Drill the combination onto the accessory end connector (5).

2.2 To choose a mounting location

- \rightarrow Choose a mounting location that is near a water tap **outside**.
- → Choose a mounting location that prevents water from entering the building in the event of a leak.
- → Choose a mounting location that is protected against direct sunlight so that the product, hose and the water won't overheat.
- \rightarrow Choose a stable and flat wall.
- → Check the stability of the wall to ensure it is strong enough to support the weight of the hose reel.

2.3 To mount the wall bracket [Fig. B1, B2, B3]

- 1. Mark the position of the 4 drill holes with a pencil through the 4 holes of the wall bracket (8).
- 2. Drill the 4 drill holes into the wall.
- 3. Put the anchors (1) into the drill holes.
- → If mounting to solid wood screw the bolts directly into the wood without anchors.
- 4. Drive the wall bracket (a) completly to the wall with the bolts (a) and washers (a).
- 5. Check to make sure the wall bracket is secure and does not wiggle.

2.4 To mount the hose reel to the wall bracket [Fig. C]

CAUTION!

▲ Risk of crushing between product and bracket!
 The product can be swivelled 180°. Body parts between hose reel and bracket can be injured.
 → Do not reach between the product and the holder.

- 1. Pay attention to a secure footing and carry the hose reel as close to your body as possible.
- 2. Place the hose reel ① with the holding tube ⑫ on the wall bracket ⑧ with both hands.

2.5 To connect the hose to the faucet [Fig. D]

 \rightarrow Drill the tab connector (2) into the faucet.

2.6 To shift the stopper ball [Fig. E]

NOTICE!

Complete pulling in of the watering hose.

Never simultaneously release the accessory end connector (5) and the stopper ball (6).

- → Never let the hose retract without the stopper in place.
 → If the hose has been pulled all the way in, please contact GARDENA Service.
- 1. Loosen the 2 bolts (3) on the stopper ball (6) with a screwdriver.
- 2. Hold the watering hose 1 securely while shifting.
- 3. Shift the stopper ball (6) and screw tightly again with the 2 bolts (1).

3. OPERATION

▲ CAUTION!

Crushing and entanglement hazard due to high spring force.

- → Keep your fingers, hair, clothing and all other objects away from the hose and inlet shaft!
- ightarrow Keep children away from the product.
- \rightarrow Check the product for damage before retracting and unwinding.
- \rightarrow Do not use a damaged product.
- → Keep people and animals away from the product while it is in use.

3.1 To unwind the hose

 \rightarrow Pull out the hose to desired length.

3.2 To retract the hose

∧ CAUTION!

A Risk of injury due to uncontrolled hose feed. \rightarrow Do not allow the hose to be pulled in without supervision.

- \rightarrow Keep people and animals away from the hose feed.
- 1. Release the locking device by pulling briefly on the hose.
- 2. Hold the end of the hose firmly and walk the hose back to the reel with the nozzle ④.

The hose rolls up securely and evenly on its own. The locking mechanism clicks during unwinding and roll-up.

3.3 About the water stop connector

The accessory end connector (5) includes a water stop connector. With no watering tool inserted water cannot flow through the water stop connector.

4. TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE

NOTICE!

Damage to the product during the frost period.

- The hose reel is not frost-proof.
- → Remove the hose reel from the wall in winter to prevent frost damage.

4.1 To transport the product

 \rightarrow Empty the hose before transporting it.

4.2 To store the product

→ Store the hose reel in a location that is out of the reach of children.
